It has long been a tradition at Heathfield to take all of our Year 7 students to Pinkery Outdoor Education Centre early on in the Autumn term.

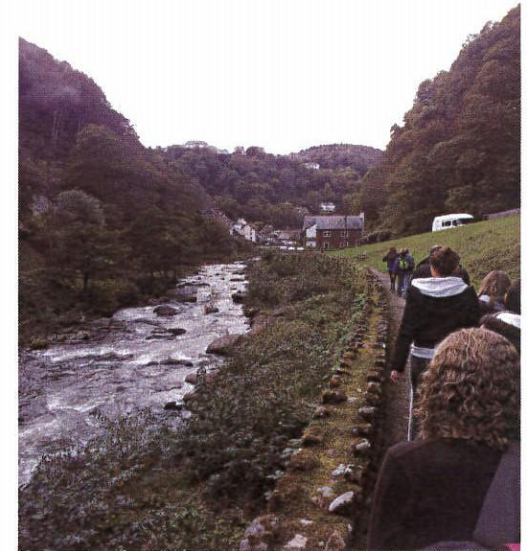
